Submission Guidelines

Established in 1999, *The Oswald Review* is the first refereed undergraduate journal devoted exclusively to criticism and research in the discipline of English. Published annually, *The Oswald Review* accepts submissions from undergraduates in this country and abroad (with a professor's endorsement).

Submit each manuscript as a separate email attachment in Microsoft Word. **TOR** discourages simultaneous submission to other journals.

All text should be provided in current MLA format, justified left only and without headers and footers. Endnotes should be avoided.

Title page:

title of work; author's name; postal address (both local and permanent); phone number (both school and home, if applicable); email address (both school and home, if applicable); name and address of college or university; name and department of endorsing professor.

Professor's note (this can be sent as a separate email message) that work is original with the student for a specific course.

Length: 5-25 pages.

Typeface: Times New Roman 12 pt.

Deadline for submissions: March 31 (or nearest business day).

Notification of acceptance by email: July 30
