Ian JAMIESON: M.A., University of New Zealand; Ph.D., University of Edinburgh. His dissertation discussed Henryson's source material in the Fabillis and the shorter poems, and he has published on this subject in Words, Wai-ie-Ata Studies in English (Wellington, N.
