Panorama, 1944, depicts the 1321st Engineer General Service Regiment, Company F, sitting on a bridge built during field training in South Carolina. This regiment, a segregated African American Army Corps of Engineers unit, was tasked with building and maintaining supply routes during World War II. Prior to deploying to France and Germany in December 1944, soldiers trained in the various building and engineering trades. While in Europe, the Regiment built and maintained bridges and roads vital to maintaining supply lines, as well as overseeing buildings used for supply storage. **Acquired through the Rebecca R.
