Menu, 19 January 1916, added to the library's collection of records of the German Friendly Society, lists courses, toasts, and music for the 150th anniversary banquet of society held at Freundschafts-Bund Hall in Charleston. Toasts were offered to "Our Founders and Their Fatherland," "Our Country," and "Our City." Also included are facsimiles of member lists from the first and second meetings of the society, attendee lists from the fiftieth and one-hundredth anniversary banquets, and a listing of current officers and members.

The German Friendly Society was founded in Charleston in 1766 as a social and mutual-assistance society. It is still active today as a social and charitable organization. **Acquired for the Library by the University South Caroliniana Society.**
