### **CHAIRMAN'S FOREWORD**

The Annual Survey of South Carolina Law is a continuing project of the South Carolina Bar Association, its preparation being the task of a committee appointed by the President of the Association from the Association membership. The review of the cases in each of the several legal fields is the responsibility of the committee member assigned that field. In the preparation of the various articles there is no attempt to adopt any uniform mode of treatment and, within very wide limits of editorial uniformity of format, the style as well as the content of each article is that of its author.

Herein presented is the fifth Annual Survey, covering a period from April 1, 1957, through March 31, 1958, and embracing all opinions of the South Carolina Supreme Court as well as opinions of the Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals and the United States Supreme Court involving South Carolina substantive law. Also, principal legislation in each of the several fields enacted by the 1958 session of the General Assembly is summarized by the committee member assigned the particular topic.

The committee wishes to acknowledge the capable services of the staff of the *South Carolina Law Quarterly* in the editing and publication of the Survey. Entitled to particular credit is Mr. Charles M. Gibson, Editor-in-Chief, who also served as special editor in charge of the Survey issue.
