## CONTRIBUTORS TO THIS ISSUE

William MONTGOMERIE: Of Dundee. Author of several volumes of poetry. Continues his bibliography which was originally submitted to Edinburgh University for the Ph.D.

Kenneth A. ROBB: Assistant Professor of English at Bowling Green State University. Has published articles on the English language and on the novel. Assistant editor of *Conradiana*. Currently doing research on Elizabeth Gaskell.

Alexander SCOTT: Senior Lecturer in Scottish Literature at Glasgow University, Secretary of the Universities' Committee on Scottish Literature, and General Editor of "The Scottish Library." Author of a critical biography of William Soutar, *Still Life*, and editor of Soutar's *Diaries of a Dying Man*, *Selected Poems of William Jeffrey*, and the poems of his 16th century namesake Alexander Scott. Co-editor with Norman MacCaig of *Contemporary Scottish Verse 1959-1969* (London: Calder and Boyars, 1970). Has published three verse plays and four collections of poems in Scots and English.

G. A. M. WOOD: Has taught at Yale University and the University of California, Santa Barbara; now with the University of Stirling. Is collecting Walter Scott letters which were not published in the edition prepared by Grierson, and is preparing an edition of Scott's *Redgauntlet*, based on the manuscript and proof sheets.
