REPORT OF
ACADEMIC FORWARD PLANNING COMMITTEE

The Academic Forward Planning Committee considers it unwise at this time to adopt a blanket policy on course offerings and degree credits on a campus or system-wide basis. The Academic Forward Planning Committee feels strongly that courses offered by the University should be judged on their merits and their need. The Academic Forward Planning Committee contends that courses should continue to be evaluated by the Curricula and Courses Committee, the Faculty Senate and ultimately the Faculty.

The decision to accept credit toward a degree should rest with the faculties of individual departments and colleges subject to the approval of the appropriate faculty bodies. Accordingly the Academic Forward Planning Committee does not support the motion offered by the Curricula and Courses Committee.
