I. COLLEGE OF HEALTH

Experimental courses - For the Senate's information only:

- HPRE 542X ALCOHOL/DRUGS AND PUBLIC HEALTH. (3) Addresses public health knowledge about use and abuse of psychoactive substances. Designed to prepare those seeking foundations in alcohol and drug use and abuse prevention.
- HPRE 552X MEDICAL ANTHROPOLOGY: CONCEPTS AND METHODS. (3) Introduction to medical anthropology in public health. Emphasis placed on concepts and methods: cultural ecology and political and cultural factors in health.
