The Library Committee met monthly to hear reports from various parts of the library system. The major news of these reports, especially concerning the new computer facilities, has been communicated directly by the Library to the Faculty.

The Committee began a series of brief visits to Colleges and Departments to hear peoples' suggestions about ways to improve library services. These suggestions were passed on to the library administration and in many cases immediate corrective action was taken (see Terry's July 28 memo to all faculty and staff.) About a third of the academic units on the Columbia campus were visited, but the visits seemed so useful that the Committee may continue them, perhaps settling into a three-year cycle of visits.
