

The Committee met three times in October to assist the Student Government Association (SGA) in the development of a course evaluation tool and process. The course evaluation process was explained by Mr. Boswell in a letter sent to all faculty in late October. Participation was encouraged but voluntary. The course evaluations were done on November 9, 1981. The data was collected and published by the S.G.A. as a course guide for Fall 1982 courses.

In May 1982, the Committee Chairperson was contacted by Ashley Abel, in-coming President, S.G.A., and was asked to assist in their efforts to permanently close Greene Street between its current temporary boundaries. The help sought was Committee support of a resolution to be presented to the University Faculty at their May 4, 1982 meeting. Faculty Committee members were phoned and the majority favored the resolution. Copies of the resolution were made through S.G.A. and circulated to all faculty at the May 4th faculty meeting. The Committee Chairperson (faculty) moved that the resolution be adopted by the University faculty. The resolution was adopted.
