

## ANNUAL REPORT

### Faculty Advisory Committee (Academic Year 1993-94)

The Faculty Advisory Committee met nine times during the academic year 1993-94. The following matters were considered:

- 1) Personnel actions involving two faculty members;
- 2) A proposal to limit the terms of members of the Faculty Senate to two years (recommendation presented to the Senate);
- 3) Faculty attendance at commencement exercises;
- 4) Faculty review of new program and degree proposals;
- 5) Sexual harassment and consensual sexual relations policies (recommendations presented to the Senate);
- 6) Policy regarding the use of the title "distinguished professor";
- 7) Policy on religious observances at the University (a report sent to the Senate);
- 8) A proposal to move the College of Criminal Justice to the College of Humanities and Social Sciences (a public hearing was held in May and a report and recommendation was forwarded to the Faculty Senate).

The new Chair of the Committee will be determined at the August meeting.
