The Secretary, Board of Trustees, will serve as Secretary of the Committee.

The Office of the Secretary, Board of Trustees, will staff the Committee, handling expenditures for the work, providing the space and resources for its meetings and files, and coordinating other staff support as required. The Treasurer will transfer funds from appropriate accounts, as needed, to support this work.

A Staff Advisory Group will include the Faculty Senate Steering Committee, the Senior Vice President for Personnel, or her designee, and the University General Counsel.

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Search Process and Time Frame

- June 6, 1990 The six Board of Trustees representatives elect the Chairman of the Presidential Candidate Search Committee.

- 2 Months..... Presidential Candidate Search Committee solicits nominations and applications, engages in candidate research, and insures compliance with all Federal, State, and University regulations, guidelines and policies.

- 2 1/2 Months Presidential Candidate Search Committee continues and completes interviewing and screening process, recommending not more than nine candidates to the Executive Committee.

- 1 1/2 Months Executive Committee interviews and ranks candidates, recommending not more than three to the Board of Trustees.

- 1 Month Board of Trustees makes final selection.
