

REPORT OF  
FACULTY SENATE STEERING COMMITTEE

The committee received a request from the University Campuses Senate for inclusion of a representative on the "new" Committee on Libraries. This request was based on the fact that there was a University Campus representative on the former appointed Library Committee. It was also stressed that these campuses are very dependent upon the Columbia campus for sharing specialized material.

The Faculty Senate Steering Committee at first view, saw no problem with enlarging the membership and in the November 1988 agenda submitted such a recommendation. Some negative feelings were expressed to the proposing committee and the recommendation was withdrawn and sent to Faculty Advisory Committee for study. Faculty Advisory returned the item to Faculty Senate Steering Committee with no recommendation for or against the proposal. Following further discussion in Faculty Senate Steering, it was decided to recommend the following motion:

That the Committee on Libraries membership be enlarged to seven elected members, including a representative of the University Campuses. This member would be elected by the University Campus Senate.
