PROPOSED ACADEMIC REGULATION FOR COLUMBIA CAMPUS

In order to receive a degree from the Columbia campus, students must take their last thirty hours on the Columbia campus.

The purpose of this regulation is to encourage students seeking a degree from the Columbia campus to be on this campus using its full facilities for at least a year of their work. The only regulation at present is the requirement that half the major work be completed at the degree granting campus. A large number of students are transferring to the Columbia campus from the two year campuses, in particular, having completed all but the final hours of their major. This policy would make the University regulations more consistent by adopting the rule which is now in effect at the campuses at Spartanburg and Coastal.
