

FACULTY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

ANNUAL REPORT 1983-84

The Faculty Advisory Committee met regularly after each meeting of the Faculty Senate and on other occasions by special call for a total of eleven meetings.

Major items of business for the year included:

1. Interpretation, in consultation with the Chairman of the Faculty Senate and the Provost, of the Academic Grievance Procedures with respect to non-reappointment of untenured faculty.
2. Recommendation to the Senate for a modification of wording in the Academic Grievance Procedures to make it consistent with the tenure and Promotion Procedures.
3. Recommendation to the Faculty of a modification in wording of the Tenure and Promotion Procedures clarifying the grounds for appeal under the Academic Grievance Procedure.
4. Recommendation to the Senate that the Senate Steering Committee consult with the Administration on budgetary matters on a regular basis.
5. Recommendation to the Senate the creation of a University Academic Responsibility Committee.
6. Reviewed and approved the draft of the new Faculty Manual.
7. Sent to the Senate Steering Committee a policy statement concerning membership on faculty committees by persons in administrative positions.
8. Recommendation to the Senate that the date for annual reports of faculty committees be changed from the spring to the first fall meeting of the Senate.
9. Discussed with the Provost many items of concern to the faculty - especially items referred to Faculty Advisory by members of the faculty.
10. The Chairman participated, ex officio, on the Senate Steering Committee and on the Academic Affairs and Faculty Liaison Committee of the Board of Trustees.
