

REPORT OF THE FACULTY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

- I. The Faculty Advisory Committee recommends a change in the Faculty Manual, page 22, to add the underlined sentences.

Grade Change Committee. This committee shall consider requests for grade changes and shall recommend to the Faculty Senate the appropriate action on these requests. The committee is composed of five faculty members appointed by the chairman of the Faculty Senate. The members shall serve terms of three years, with two members appointed annually, except every third year one member shall be appointed.

Approved

Bookstore Committee. This committee recommends to the Faculty Senate action on all questions and problems concerning the policies of the Campus Bookstore. The committee is composed of six members appointed by the chairman of the Faculty Senate. The members shall serve terms of three years, with two members appointed annually.

- II. The Faculty Advisory Committee recommends that the Faculty-Student Committee on Teaching Evaluation (Faculty Manual, page 20) be abolished as a permanent committee of the Faculty Senate.

Approved

The work of this committee could be performed by other permanent committees of the faculty or by an ad hoc committee, whichever was appropriate. A permanent committee for this limited and narrowly defined purpose seems unnecessary.
