REPORT OF THE FACULTY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Committee recommends the adoption of the following changes concerning the Committee on Scholastic Standards and Petitions:

(In the Faculty Senate Minutes (May, 1979) make the following changes)

Delete the following:

A student whose petition has been denied by a College Committee or Scholastic Standards and Petitions may appeal such a decision to the University Committee which will review the case for compliance with due process. In the case of students in the undeclared major program the University Committee will act as a court of original jurisdiction.

Substitute the following:

"The University Committee on Scholastic Standards and Petitions will act as a court of original jurisdiction on all petitions by students in the undeclared major programs. The Committee shall also review and act upon decisions made by College petitions committees when appealed by the student or the dean of the college."

On page 23 of the current Faculty Manual make the following changes:

Delete the following:

The College Committee is also authorized to act on petitions for:

1. Waiver of the requirement that candidates for baccalaureate degrees must be in residence for the final 30 hours of their program;
2. Permission to repeat a course previously passed for credit;
3. Waiver of any regulations established by the College Committee;
4. Reinstatement following suspension from the University and for reinstatement to a particular degree program.

and

A student whose petition has been denied by the College Committee may appeal the decision to the University Committee.

Substitute the following:

"The College Committee is also authorized to act on petitions concerning University and College academic regulations."

and

"A student whose petition has been denied by the College Committee may appeal the decision to the University Committee."
