REPORT OF FACULTY WELFARE COMMITTEE

SUBJECT: Resolution of the Faculty Welfare Committee to Be Submitted to the Faculty Senate on April 1, 1992

Whereas, the proper functioning of the University requires timely access by faculty/staff, and because faculty/staff frequently have problems obtaining parking space at many times during the day, which is a major source of lost productivity, and

Whereas, this is a long-standing problem that promises to continue unless changes are made, the Faculty Welfare Committee proposes policy changes that will improve faculty/staff access while preserving the existing system of seniority,

Therefore be it resolved that parking policies be modified on a schedule consistent with an orderly transition but as soon as possible as follows:

- 1. Z lot decals be modified to distinguish between faculty/staff and students (i.e., ZF vs ZS).
- 2. The policy of allowing anyone to park in any lot after 2:00PM be modified to permit only ZF decals this privilege until 5:00PM.
- 3. Increase the number of parking enforcement personnel in an attempt to enhance compliance, and increase revenue from illegally parked cars.
- 4. Intensify enforcement through more aggressive use of towing, which should be feasible with more enforcement personnel.
- 5. Require students to have sophomore standing (as measured by credit hours completed) to be eligible to apply for a parking decal.
- 6. Increase the parking fines.
