SUBJECT: Motions of the Grade Change Committee for the February  
Meeting of the USC Faculty Senate

The Grade Change Committee wishes to present the following motions before the USC Faculty Senate:

- (1) Grades issued by the instructor are final. Any challenge or request for a grade change must be submitted to the instructor no later than one calendar year from the date on which the grade was recorded. Notations of "IP" are exempted from this rule.
- (2) If the grade of "NR" has not been cleared one calendar year from the date on which it was recorded, it will be changed to an F.
- (3) When an emergency grade change is requested by the Dean of the college in which the student is enrolled, the full grade change committee is empowered to approve a grade change which will automatically be accepted by the Faculty Senate.

The Grade Change Committee - after consultation with the Registrar - voted unanimously to place these motions before the Faculty Senate.
