

REPORT OF
FACULTY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Having reviewed Professor Richard Conant's recommendation concerning the Student Affairs Committee and the Student-Faculty Relations Committee, the description of these committees and the membership of these committees, the Faculty Advisory Committee recommends the elimination of the Student-Faculty Relations Committee.

The Faculty Advisory Committee agrees that there is significant overlap between the Student Affairs Committee and the Student-Faculty Relations Committee. The Committee also feels that the breadth of the charge to and the membership of the Student Affairs Committee are sufficient to handle all student affairs.

STUDENT AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

This committee is composed of six faculty members (one of whom shall be chair), six students, the Vice President for Student Affairs, and two other administrative officials appointed by the President. Its functions are to review all aspects of student life at the University outside the formal responsibility of other standing committees, including the regulation of student organizations and the operation of the Division of Student Affairs.
