

UNIVERSITY ATHLETIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE

At its November 28, 1990, meeting, the University Athletic Advisory Committee unanimously approved changes in the membership of the committee. Because it is a university committee, the proposed change must go through the Provost's Office to the University Board of Trustees, rather than through the Faculty Senate. The committee, however, has decided to include the Faculty Senate in the chain and is sending the proposal to the Senate for endorsement.

The current description of the committee's membership is on page 17 of the Faculty Manual. The committee wishes to change that description to the following (with the reason for the change included in parentheses):

CURRENT

UNIVERSITY ATHLETIC
ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Membership of the committee
will be

1. five elected faculty members -- two faculty representatives shall be elected each year for a term of three years except that every third year one member shall be elected for three years;
2. three student members (appointed by the president of the student body);

PROPOSED

UNIVERSITY ATHLETICS
ADVISORY COMMITTEE

(The word "athletic" in the existing title should be "athletics;" otherwise, it makes a statement about the physical condition of the committee's members rather than describing on what topic it advises.)

Membership of the committee
will be

1. six elected faculty members -- two faculty members shall be elected each year for a term of three years; (Revision would allow for consistency and better ensure continuity.)
2. three student members -- two undergraduates appointed by the president of the student body and one graduate student appointed by the graduate dean; (Graduate students are a large segment of our student population and should be represented.)

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3. one member of the Inter-collegiate Activities Committee of the Board of Trustees (appointed by the chair of that committee);

4. four presidential appointments -- one each from the faculty at large, Division of Business Affairs, Division of Student Affairs, Athletic Department.

3. no change

4. four presidential appointments -- one at-large from the faculty, the staff or the administration; the NCAA and/or SEC representative; one from the Division of Student Affairs; and the Director of Athletics. (The change in the first presidential appointment, one from the faculty at large, makes it possible for a representative from any of the large University groups to be named. Certainly, the NCAA and/or SEC representative should be on the committee. And, it has been most useful to have the Athletics Director in regular attendance at committee meetings.)
