REPORT: COMMITTEE ON CURRICULA AND COURSES

(For consideration by the Faculty Senate at its meeting on September 12, 1979)

[The Committee requests that any department which has a proposal being recommended by the Committee on Curricula and Courses provide a spokesman to attend the Faculty Senate meeting in which said proposal is to be recommended.]

The Committee recommends approval of the following changes in courses:

I. COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION - *Approved*

Change in title and description

FROM: BADM 666 REAL ESTATE AND URBAN LAND ECONOMICS. (No prereq) (3) Factors affecting real estate and urban development decisions in private and public sectors. Emerging problems and changing directions in the urban development process. Topics include real estate values, valuation, location and market factors, land development and utilization, management, marketing, financing, and special contemporary problems.

TO: BADM 666 REAL ESTATE AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT. (3) An overview of real estate in both the public and private sectors that serves as the basis for advanced study in the various disciplines of real estate and urban development. No prior knowledge of the field is assumed.

II. COLLEGE OF HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES - *Approved*

A. Department of Art

Change in title, prerequisites and description

FROM: ARTS 549 CRAFTS: TEXTILES. (3) (Prereq: ARTS 349 or consent of instructor) The design and construction of craft objects in various textile materials.

TO: ARTS 549 ADVANCED FIBER ARTS. (3) (Prereq: ARTS 249 or 349 or consent of instructor) Advanced techniques in weaving, felting, spinning, wrapping and surface design; emphasizes design and conceptual development.

III. COLLEGE OF JOURNALISM

Change in corequisites

- FROM: JOUR 400L PHOTOJOURNALISM LABORATORY. (1) (Coreq: appropriate journalism course) Laboratory for photojournalism courses (JOUR 329 (400a), 337 (400b), 538 (400c). May not be taken separately.
- TO: JOUR 400L PHOTOJOURNALISM LABORATORY. (1) (Coreq: appropriate journalism course) Laboratory for photojournalism courses (JOUR 329 (400a), 337 (400b). May not be taken separately.
- FROM: JOUR 538 ADVANCED PHOTOJOURNALISM. (2) (Prereq: JOUR 329 or 337 or equivalent; Coreq: JOUR 400C) Photo essay, picture story, feature picture and news photography. Photojournalistic history and current issues.
- TO: JOUR 538 ADVANCED PHOTOJOURNALISM. (2) (Prereq: JOUR 329 or 337 or equivalent; Coreq: JOUR 500L) Photo essay, picture story, feature picture and news photography. Photojournalistic history and current issues.

New course

JOUR 500L PHOTOJOURNALISM LABORATORY. (1) (Coreq: JOUR 538) Laboratory for advanced photojournalism course. May not be taken separately.
