

REPORT OF THE FACULTY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Faculty Advisory Committee, in conjunction with the Admissions Committee, has prepared and now recommends the following description of the Admissions Committee:

This committee shall consider University policies on entrance examinations, admissions and readmissions and will recommend to the Faculty Senate changes in policy as these are deemed advisable.

To assure conformity with university undergraduate admissions policies the committee will review policies and changes proposed by faculties of the various academic units.

The committee will act on appeals of persons who seek admission to the University but fail to fulfil established standards of admission or readmission.

Responsibilities of this committee are confined to matters dealing with undergraduate admissions to the University.

Of the ten members, five members of this committee shall be elected by the faculty and five appointed by the President. Two faculty representatives shall be elected each year for a term of three years except every third year one member shall be elected for three years. The Director of Admissions shall serve as secretary to the committee without voting privileges.

The Faculty Advisory Committee, working with the Committee on Scholastic Standards and Petitions, has prepared and now recommends the following description of the Committee on Scholastic Standards and Petitions:

This committee shall consider matters concerning academic requirements and standards. The Committee will review current policies and practices and proposed changes and make recommendations to the appropriate college faculty or to the Faculty Senate.

A student whose petition has been denied by a College Committee or Scholastic Standards and Petitions may appeal such a decision to the University Committee which will review the case for compliance with due process. In the case of students in the undeclared major program the University Committee will act as a court of original jurisdiction.

As a regular faculty committee, the membership of the committee shall include six faculty members elected in accordance with the guidelines provided above under FACULTY COMMITTEES. In addition, there shall be two student members who shall be designated by the President of the Student Government Association and confirmed by the Student Senate. The Registrar shall serve as an ex-officio member without voting privileges. The chairman of the committee shall be notified of the student appointees no later than October 1 of the year in which they will serve.
