The Committee reviewed and endorsed the following changes to be included in the Fall 1991 Bulletin:

PROPOSED:

COGNATES. In addition to satisfactorily completing all courses in the major field of study, a student must also satisfactorily complete a minimum of 12 hours in advanced courses related to the major, but outside the major, as prescribed by the major department.

All cognate courses must be passed with a grade of C or higher.

The following courses fulfill some of the General Education Requirements and must be completed for a B.A. or B.S. degree in economics: ECON 221 and 222 with a minimum grade of C or ECON 224 with a minimum grade of C; MATH 122 or MATH 141; and STAT 201.
