Re: Proposal from the College of Journalism and Mass Communications

The Standards and Petitions Committee has approved the enclosed proposal from the College of Journalism and Mass Communications. The purpose of the proposed changes to entrance and progression requirements is to

- 1.) Set the requirements to enter the College from another college of the University or from another four year institution at a minimum gpa of 2.250. Transfers from two year institutions must have a 2.500 gpa in order to be admitted.
- 2.) Set the progression requirement to remain in good academic standing at a minimum gpa of 2.250.
- 3.) Require that all majors within the College must pass all major courses applied to the degree with a grade of C or better. Require that journalism students must have a minimum cumulative gpa of 2.250 on all journalism courses attempted in order to graduate.
