TOPIC: Annual report of the Scholastic Standards and Petitions
Committee for the 1978-79 academic year.

The Scholastic Standards and Petitions Committee met as needed during the 1978-79 academic year to consider the following items:

1. recommendations to the Faculty Advisory Committee concerning the mission of the Scholastic Standards and Petitions Committee, its composition, election of its members, and its description in the Faculty Manual;
2. eleven petitions by students in various programs;
3. changes in the regulations concerning dropping a course and usage of the W grade;
4. usage of the I grade and clarification of its description in the University Bulletin;
5. treatment of transfer grades in GPR computations for admission to USC, for admission to USC degree programs, and for graduation with honors;
6. treatment of transfer plus-grades brought in prior to implementation of the plus-system at USC;
7. changes to the Baccalaureate and Associate Degree Programs of the College of Nursing;
8. admission and retention standards for the Medical Technology Program of the College of Nursing;
9. review of various grading systems in use at USC; and
10. review of scholastic standards and petition policies and operations of all colleges.
