**Class and Laboratory Attendance**

Students enrolled in the College of Pharmacy are expected to attend all classes, recitations, clerkships, externships, and laboratories and University attendance requirements must be fulfilled. A student must attend 90 percent of lectures and 100 percent of the laboratories in each pharmacy course. Laboratory, recitation, clerkships, externships, and examination makeups will be permitted only in the case of excused absences.

Clerkship sites may require special immunization for students to be on rotations at the site. Students may be required to obtain the required immunizations at their own expense prior to their clinical rotation.

**Class and Laboratory  
Attendance**

Students enrolled in the College of Pharmacy are expected to attend all classes, recitations, clerkships, externships, and laboratories and University attendance requirements must be fulfilled. A student must attend 90 percent of lectures and 100 percent of the laboratories in each pharmacy course. Laboratory, recitation, clerkship, externship, and examination makeups will be permitted only in the case of excused absences. All students must show proof of TB skin-testing and immunization against Tuberculosis, Rubella, Rubeola, Varicella, and

Tetanus, and a complete physical examination before entering the clinical practicum of the professional program. In addition, all students should be immunized against Hepatitis B or have an informed refusal document on file before starting the clinical practicum phase of the professional program. All students must purchase liability insurance through the College of Pharmacy before entering the clinical practicum of the professional program.

### **Justification**

Clinical clerkship sites and externship sites require immunizations for those stated and recommend immunization for Hepatitis B.

Liability insurance is also a requirement and must be obtained from the State Insurance program for the following reasons:

1. It is the least expensive for the student.
2. It is the best mechanism for the college to assure uniform coverage for them as students. Students may be working in pharmacies and may have one of many liability policies offered. They may or may not be covered in a student role in such policies.
3. Purchase of liability insurance through the state is a routine event for all health science students.
