

REPORT OF  
SCHOLASTIC STANDARDS AND PETITIONS COMMITTEE

The Scholastic Standards and Petitions Committee met on March 17th. and approved the following items to be considered by the Faculty Senate.

In July 1985 the Faculty Senate amended the wording on p. 17U of the University Bulletin to read as follows: "Academic courses must be completed with a grade of C or better at regionally accredited institutions in order to be counted toward a degree at the University of South Carolina."

This was done in order to make explicit in the Bulletin the practice that was actually being followed by most Colleges of the University.

The new wording, however, was not incorporated into the current Bulletin because of a perceived ambiguity in the wording. The Scholastic Standards and Petitions Committee has intensively restudied the issue and proposes the following changes.

New paragraph to be inserted as the 3rd. paragraph under Course Credit on p. U18:

Courses taken within the University System and completed with a grade of A through D are accepted throughout the System by the Dean of the college in which the student enrolls. Certain programs require a minimum grade of C for major courses, or other specified courses.

New paragraph to be inserted as the second paragraph under Transfer Credit on p. U18.

In order to be transferred to the University of South Carolina, academic courses taken at other regionally accredited institutions must be completed with a grade of C- or better.
