The University Scholastic Standards and Petitions Committee unanimously recommends for adoption the following change in the University requirements for graduation: (1983-84 Bulletin, page 16U)

Current

GRADUATION

Each student will submit to his academic dean a list of courses, meeting all regulations and requirements of his school or college and his major department, which he claims for graduation and for which the GPR is at least 2.00. This list, after verification, will form the basis of the dean's approval or rejection of the student's application for graduation. (Note: Obviously this list would contain only courses in which the student had performed at or above the required level).

Proposed

GRADUATION

In order to be eligible for graduation, students must meet all course requirements, be in good academic standing, meet any departmental or program requirements, and have a cumulative GPR of at least 2.00 on all work attempted at U.S.C.
