The following is a summary of significant actions taken by the Committee during the academic year:

1. Met with Registrar to familiarize selves with problem of forged, approved Grade Change requests. Adopted an official seal with which to identify approved grade changes for the Registrar.
2. Met with Registrar to be appraised of disruption caused his operation by the assignment of "W" grades (for extenuating circumstances after penalty date) that become effective on dates other than those on which a student has ceased to attend a course.
3. Reminded individual Faculty members, and Scholastic Standards and Petitions Committee agents, that grade change requests in which extenuating circumstances play a major role need to be accompanied by credible documentation.
