


Annual Report
of the
University Athletic Advisory Committee

The Athletic Advisory Committee met eight times during the year. These meetings included sessions with Bob Marcum, Director of Athletics and Bill Foster, Head Coach of Basketball, as well as visits to the athletic facilities at the football stadium and at the Coliseum. In addition, the Committee met once with President Holderman to discuss presidential admits and the Chairman of the Committee attended three meetings of the Intercollegiate Activities Committee of the Board of Trustees, twice in executive session. The Chairman also responded to invitations to attend the Coach's Caravan of the Metro Conference and the football banquet. During the year, the Chairman, by action of the Faculty Senate, was appointed to the Senate Steering Committee, where he served for the remainder of the year.

The Committee this year received the first of what will become regular reports on the academic status of athletes at the University. The Registrar presented reports in the Fall and Spring semesters on the status of continuing student-athletes while the Director of Admissions presented reports on new student-athlete admissions. These reports will be maintained in the Registrar's Office and were reviewed by the Committee at the time of presentation.

Two special reports were undertaken at the request of the Senate Steering Committee -- one on presidential admits and one reviewing the academic progress of an entering class of football players. These reports were presented to the Committee, and the Chairman, in turn, will convey the results to the Senate Steering Committee.
